## Community Supported Agriculture 2010 Membership Agreement

Members will receive a weekly share of the harvest for twenty-five (25) weeks during the growing season of 2010. Share boxes will be delivered to a designated drop point beginning on or about May 1<sup>st</sup>, depending on early spring crop development levels. Members will arrive during designated times at the designated point to receive the weekly share box. If a member is unable to receive the weekly share box they may designate a friend or relative to receive it in their place, but no other alternative arrangement, drop point, or time will be made. Credit or replacement share boxes will not be issued for missed pickups. Members understand that Colvin Family Farm is a working farm and a private residence but is not a retail distribution point, and therefore may not stop in at the farm for the purpose of picking up a share box, except by special invitation. Members may stop by the farm during business hours (by appointment) for the purpose of observing or assisting (when appropriate) in farm work. Colvin Family Farm staff will make every effort to discuss and explain our activities, methods, and practices with members when interested.

Members will be provided a prospective list of crops grown during the season but understand that variations may be necessary. Members understand that weather, insects, and other natural events (such as mud slides, typhoons, earthquakes, and glaciers) may dictate the success or failure of various crops. The goal of Colvin Family Farm is to provide top quality produce varieties at or above the retail value of the share box. **Members understand that the nature of community supported agriculture is one of shared risk for the purpose of ensuring a fresh, local, and healthy food supply system and therefore are not assured of receiving any specific value.**

Members are strongly encouraged to attend one (or more) of our annual Farm Field Days.

We believe one of the most important aspects of a CSA, is the direct connection made between farmers and consumers, we think that one of the best ways to meet us, is by meeting our farm—we hope that you will!
